Congratulations to Mark Keppel's Academic Decathlon Team for another successful season. After earning 42 medals at the LA County Competition where they finished 2nd, they earned 18 medals at the California Academic Decathlon this past weekend. Out of the 300 high schools that competed in California, MKHS finished 4th this year. Individually, Justin Xu finished 5th and Bosco Nguyen finished 1st respectively among Junior Team members at LA County. Ali Lin finished 3rd and Jerry Fan finished 1st respectively among all Scholastic students at LA County. Amber Kuo finished with the 3rd highest score at the LA County Competition and Ivan Luu was the TOP overall scorer in all of LA County! Ivan Luu is also our top scorer at CAD with 9,257 points.
